Indeed, when we see how others struggle for basic amenities like clean water, adequate sanitation, health care and education, we are reminded that we have lucked out to be living in Canada where these basic services are taken for granted.

We also are a country of tolerance and compassion and part of that character is shown in the way we assist others less fortunate.

CanAssist is currently working to install latrines at a girls school in Kenya and a school in rural Uganda and water catchment in two others. We are embarking on installation of a security fence for a clinic in Uganda, and are constructing school

furnishings for three schools. We are completing a classroom at a Kenyan school and planning one at another. We will soon build teachers' accommodations at a Tanzanian school and are planning for six classrooms in conjunction with World's Collide in the Congo.
